with ripe notes of red cherries, plums, and hints of chocolate. The addition of Petite Sirah, a variety we began growing in 1968, adds flavors of blueberry, boysenberry, and hints of black pepper. Finishing in new French oak imparts hints of toasty oak and a rich, silky mouthfeel.

Aged in one-year old American oak for 12 months, finished in new French oak for 2 months.

The wine opens to reveal lifted fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, and vanilla, along with toasty oak notes.

-Rex Hill Winery, Pinot Noir Willamette Valley 16

Rich, dark berries, pomegranate, rhubarb, caramel, mulling spices, and tobacco with secondary hints of balsa wood, flint, slate, and graphite.

-Alexander Valley Vineyards Merlot 10

Broad mouthfeel with flavors of cherry, cassis, blackberry, plum and chocolate. Big, nicely balanced wine with chewy tannins on the long finish.

-Pessimist Paso Robles Red Blend 12

Powerful and intensely aromatic nose with blueberry, boysenberry and black plum fragrance. Evolving layers reveal elderberry and truffle, with cocoa and cardamom spice accents, further augmented by hints of eucalyptus, leather, cherry pipe tobacco and grilled meats.
